Ron Nachman is a fourth generation Sabra, born to the founding family of the City of Nes Ziona. He holds a BA in Political Science and an additional degree in Law from Tel Aviv University. Mr. Nachman is married and father of four daughters.



From 1970 - 1983, he was employed by the Israeli Military Industries, where he held the position of Deputy Director General of the R & D division.

From 1983 - 1985, he served as Deputy Director General of the Israel Broadcasting Authority.

In 1978 - Ron Nachman headed the nucleus of residents that founded Ariel.

In 1985, he became the first elected Mayor of Ariel. He was re-elected Mayor in 1990, and again in 1995, 2000, 2005 and 2008.

In the Israeli national elections in June of 1992, Ron Nachman was elected to the Israeli Knesset, the only Likud member of Knesset from Judea, Samaria and Gaza.
