***After Israel's Election:
How Israel & the Jewish Community

Israel faces existential crises from several sources - the possibility of a nuclear Iran, the radicalization of the Islamic world, incitement by the Palestinian Authority to hatred and terrorism, and pressure to surrender vital portions of its own land to allow for the creation of a Palestinian state. Meanwhile, Prime Minister Netanyahu's new coalition resulting from the recent election is likely to have far greater influence of parties to the left of Likud. Prof. Sion will discuss strategy for confronting these pressures.

Prof. Abraham Sion is a graduate of the Hebrew University of Jerusalem with a Ph.D. from the University of Cambridge (U.K.). He has served as Deputy State Attorney for Israel, as President of the Board of Directors of Israel Tourist Industries, as a member of the Executive Committee of the Israeli Bar, and as a Lieutenant Colonel in the I.D.F. with 17 years of that service as a judge in Gaza. He currently has a weekly program on the popular Reshet Bet channel on Israel Radio. He is chairman of the Center for Law and Mass Media at Ariel University and currently is head of a Tel Aviv law firm actively involved in both research and advocacy of Law and Mass Media as it relates to Israel.
